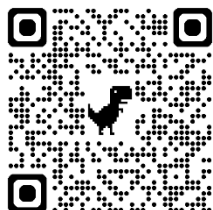

PULL SEASON SAFETY CHECK

With the pull season kicking off, I thought it would be a good time to review the EDGE&TA Safety Regs. Though we have a safety meeting before every event and all do a good job of looking out for one another's well-being, it never hurts to review the rules. Especially for those of us who have been doing this for a while.

Top listed Safety Rules on the EDGE&TA website are:

1. EDGE&TA Branch Safety Officers, EDGE&TA Safety Officers, and EDGE&TA Insurance Advisers are authorized to shut down anyone for unsafe operation.
2. Anyone exhibiting or participating at any EDGE&TA event **MUST** be a member of an EDGE&TA branch.
3. No set of requirements, regulations or cautions can prevent a disaster. We must, however, take these safety requirements seriously. Our individual awareness and adherence to both required and desired requirements will greatly increase the safety of our exhibitors and the public who attend our events.
4. No Alcohol to be Served or Consumed at Any EDGE&TA Event.
